It is always fresh, and the local stores have fresh fruits and vegetables and protein foods. The first place I ate at was an oven cooked pizza restaurant with thin bread and distilled water from a glass bottle. They serve water from bottles instead of using tap so you have to pay for water unlike in America you can ask for tap water. They also serve sparkling water as well. This includes calamari, pan con tomato tomato rubbed bread with oil cheese and meat, gazapacho chilled tomato soup, stuffed eggs, montadito of tuna-stuffed piquillo peppers, tortilla de patatas a Spanish omlette, cubbed potatos with aoli sauce, and more that I had not tried. I personally am not a fan of calamari and tomatoes, but I did try them. I ate a lot of delicious meals but when I was done, I felt full but about an hour to two hours later I was hungry again do to the fact it is a smaller portion size. I also tried a lot of different drinks they had as well including cocktails. The cocktails were sweet fruit flavored including strawberry daiquiri, tequila rose shot, mango liquor shot, Portland in it was june pear gin, raspberry, passionfruit, and orange juice and more cocktails. When it comes to keeping drinks cold in Spain, they use large ice cubes while Americans use small multiple ice cubes. For Pepsi and Coke, they put a piece of lemon in your glass which is like a garnish and can add just a bit of flavor to the pop. I have a sweet tooth and tried many sweets in Spain. In America we have ice cream in Spain they have gelato which is similar but smoother and healthier. In conclusion I give Barcelona a 8 out of 10.
